

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE

AUTHORITY: NRS 459.485

**Section 1.** Chapter 444 of NAC is hereby amended by thereto the provisions set forth in section 2.

**Sec. 2.** *1. Any authorized representative or employee of the Division or Department may, for the purpose of carrying out his or her duties pursuant to NRS 459.400 to 459.600, inclusive, or to enforce a regulation adopted pursuant to those sections:*

*a. Enter any place where waste or a substance which the Department has reason to believe may be hazardous waste or a hazardous substance is or may have been generated, stored, transported, treated, disposed of or otherwise handled;*

*b. Inspect and obtain samples of any waste or substance which the Department has reason to believe may be hazardous waste or a hazardous substance, including samples from any vehicle in which waste or substance is being transported, and samples of containers and labels; and*

*c. Take photographs and inspect and copy any records, reports, information or test results relating to the management of hazardous wastes or hazardous substances.*

*2. If entry is refused, or before attempting to enter, such authorized representative or employee may apply to any judicial officer for a search warrant. The judicial officer shall issue the warrant if the judicial officer believes from the supporting affidavit or affidavits that there is probable cause to believe that hazardous waste is generated, stored, treated, disposed of or otherwise handled on the premises to be searched.*
