

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE STATE  
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE**

**LCB File No. R158-16**

*NAC Removal of diseased bees without permit unlawful. (NRS 552.280, 552.0858)*

- 1. In the quarantine area established by NAC 554.805, all bee swarms and feral or managed bee colonies are deemed to be “diseased”.*
- 2. A person shall not collect, relocate, transport or by any means remove live diseased bees in a quarantine area without a permit.*
- 3. A person may obtain a permit to collect, relocate, transport or remove live diseased bees in a quarantine area if they:*
  - a. Complete an application as required by the Director; and,*
  - b. Acknowledge the requirement to retain a signed risk disclosure statement from the property owner of the property harboring the bees which are to be removed; and,*
  - c. Pay the fees in subsection 4.*
- 4. The Department may charge an applicant for a permit the following fees:*
  - a. A fee not to exceed \$15.00 a year for the permit.*
