

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON REGULATION
AND HEARING AGENDA**

Notice of Hearing for the Adoption, Amendment or Repeal of Regulations of
The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance

The State of Nevada, Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (“Division”), (775) 687-0700, will hold a public hearing at **9:30 a.m. on February 22, 2018**, in the 1st Floor Hearing Room, 1818 East College Parkway, Suite 103, Carson City, Nevada 89706. Interested persons may also participate through a simultaneous videoconference conducted in the 4th Floor Nevada Room at the Nevada State Business Center/Division of Insurance, 3300 West Sahara Avenue, Suite 275, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption, amendment or repeal of regulations pertaining to chapters 679B, 680A, 681A, 681B, 682A, 683A, 685A, 686B, 687B, 688A, 689B, 689C, 691B, 692A, 694C, 695B, 695C, 695D, 695F, and 696A of the Nevada Administrative Code (“NAC”).

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) 233B.0603 and the directives of the Governor:

LCB File No. R089-17. Address Change and Publication Updates. A regulation relating to insurance; revising contact information relating to the certain vendors of certain publications adopted by reference; revising the names and prices of certain publications adopted by reference; revising provisions governing the filing of certain quality and performance indicators by health maintenance organizations; revising provisions relating to the use of employee assistance programs; repealing certain provisions; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

- (1) Why is the regulation necessary and what is its purpose?

Proposed changes are to update information regarding National Association of Insurance Commissioner (“NAIC”) address change and publications issued by the NAIC and other organizations that have changed publication name, and to make other conforming changes as a result of statute changes. The latter includes: 1) a slight narrowing of the definition of a managing general agent (“MGA”) (NAC 683A.450(3)); 2) a correction to a statutory reference regarding money maintained by a nonprofit organization of brokers (NAC 685A.400(1)(c)); and 3) allowing a health maintenance organization or a provider sponsored organization to also coordinate its benefits with any policy of individual health insurance (NAC 695C.180(1)). NAC 695C.275 is also amended to replace reference to the State Board of Health with the Commissioner; and to remove the requirement of an annual report.

- (2) What are the terms or substance of the proposed regulation?

Proposed changes are to update information regarding National Association of Insurance Commissioner (“NAIC”) address change, update publications issued by the NAIC and

other organizations that have changed publication name, and to make other corrections as a result of statutory changes in 2017, 2015 and 2013, as noted above.

(3) What is the anticipated impact of the regulation on the problem(s)?

This regulation will provide accurate information to carriers. No other impacts are anticipated.

Copies of this notice and the proposed regulation will be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary. This does not apply to a public body subject to the Open Meeting Law.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, shall issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption, and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
