## Draft Proposed Amendments to NAC 701

Authority to adopt regulations is granted under NRS 701.

**Section. 1** NAC 701.185 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. The ~~[2012]~~ *Director hereby adopts by reference the International Energy Conservation Code in the form most recently approved by the International Code Council, unless the Director gives notice on or before July 1, 2018, and on or before July 1 of every third year thereafter that the most recent publication is not suitable for this State pursuant to subsection 3 [is hereby adopted by reference].*
2. ~~[On or before July 1, 2015, and on or before July 1 of every third year thereafter, the Director will review the most recent version of the International Energy Conservation Code, including any amendments thereto, and will adopt by reference the most recent version of the International Energy Conservation Code and prescribe by regulation such amendments to the most recent version of the International Energy Conservation Code as the Director deems necessary to support effective compliance with and enforcement of the International Energy Conservation Code in this State].~~ *The International Energy Conservation Code and any errata thereto published by the International Code Council may be obtained from the International Code Council, 25442 Network Place, Chicago, Illinois 60673-1254, by telephone at (800) 786-4452 or at the Internet address <http://www.iccsafe.org>. The combined International Energy Conservation Code and the latest ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1: Energy Standard for Buildings Except Low-Rise Residential Buildings may be obtained from the International Code Council. Supplemental materials to the International Energy Conservation Code may also be obtained from the International Code Council.*
3. The Director will ~~[post on an Internet website maintained by the Office the notice of adoption of the most recent version of the International Energy Conservation Code, the date of adoption and any amendments to the International Energy Conservation Code adopted by the Director by regulation.]~~ *review each revision of the publication adopted by reference pursuant to subsection 1 to determine its suitability for this State. If the Director determines that the revisions is not suitable for this State, it will hold a public hearing to review its determination and give notice of that hearing within 6 months after the date of the publication of the revision. If, after the hearing, the Director does not revise its determination, the Commission will give notice that the revision is not suitable for this State within 30 days after the hearing. If the Director does not give such notice, the revision becomes part of the publication adopted by reference pursuant to subsection 1.*

### **INTENT**

**Sec 1 (1, 3)** -To modify the code to reflect the automatic adoption of the most recent IECC version, to comply with NRS701.220 (1).

**Sec 1 (2)** - To modify the language used in code to reference current industry publications. The "errata" term was explained as the term used by IECC in place of "amendment" as previously seen.

**Sec. 2** NAC 701.187 is hereby repealed in its entirety:

**INTENT**

To remove unnecessary section
