**The following document is the initial draft regulation proposed  
by the agency submitted on 05/21/2018**

**NAC 391.391 Endorsement to teach pupils in program of orientation and mobility. (NRS 391.019)**

1. To receive an endorsement to teach pupils in a program of orientation and mobility, a person must ~~hold a~~:

(a) **Hold a** bachelor's or graduate degree in:

(1) Orientation and mobility; or

(2) Any other field of study and have successfully completed an orientation and mobility program at a university approved by the Association for Education and Rehabilitation of the Blind and Visually Impaired; or

(b) ~~Professional certificate in orientation and mobility issued by the Association for Education and Rehabilitation of the Blind and Visually Impaired.~~ ***Submit transcripts showing a bachelor's or higher degree in orientation and mobility conferred by a regionally accredited college or university, and hold a specialty credential as a Certified Orientation and Mobility Specialist from the Academy for Certification of Vision Rehabilitation and Education Professionals.***

2. Such an endorsement is not required to teach pupils in a program of orientation and mobility.
