

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION**

REQUESTED AMENDMENT TO NAC 388.XXX

REQUIRED PURSUANT TO NRS 388.255

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

Section 1. Chapter 388 of NAC is here by amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as Section 2 of this regulation.

Section 2. 1. *The boards of trustees of a school district must develop the plan required pursuant to NRS 388.243 in accordance with the provisions of NRS 388.229 to 388.253, inclusive, NRS 388.257 to 388.264, inclusive, and NRS 388.910. The governing body of each charter school must develop the plan required pursuant to NRS 388.243 in accordance with the provisions of NRS 388.229 to 388.253, inclusive, and NRS 388.257 to 388.264, inclusive. The governing body of each private school must develop the plan required pursuant to NRS 394.1687 in accordance with the provisions of NRS 388.229 to 388.253, inclusive, NRS 394.168 to 388.1692, inclusive, and NRS 394.1696 to 394.1697, inclusive.*

2. In developing the plans required by NRS 388.243 and NRS 394.1687, the board of trustees of a school district and the governing bodies of a charter school or a private school shall include all plans, procedures and information included in the model plan developed by the Department pursuant to NRS 388.253.

3. In developing the model plan required pursuant to NRS 388.253, the Department shall, to the extent possible, identify nationally accepted best practice models or frameworks for addressing the provisions and requirements of NRS 388.253.

(a) If a nationally accepted best practice model or framework cannot be identified for any provision or requirement of NRS 388.253, the Department shall consult with relevant stakeholders to develop a model or framework for use by boards of trustees of a

school district, the governing bodies of a charter school or a private school, or the administrator of a school in complying with that provision or requirement. Such stakeholders may include:

(1) other state agencies, including but not limited to those identified in subsection 1 of NRS 388.253; and

(2) governing bodies, educational personnel, local associations and organizations of parents whose children are enrolled in schools throughout this State, and individual parents and legal guardians whose children are enrolled in schools throughout this State.

4. Except as prohibited by NRS 388.258 to 388.261, inclusive, and NRS 394.1698 to 394.1699, inclusive, the models or frameworks identified or developed to address any provision or requirement of NRS 388.253 shall be presented to the Board and posted on the Internet website maintained by the Department.
