PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE  
NEVADA DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

August 30, 2021

**Explanation:** Matter in *bold italics* is new material; matter in ~~red~~ is material proposing to be omitted.

**Purpose:** To adopt regulations under the Nevada Administrative Code, as provided by Assembly Bill 349 of the 2021 Session, requiring the Department to adopt regulations necessary to implement the provisions specified. The adopted regulations will revise certain procedures with respect to fees for issuance and renewal of licenses for additional testing stations; time for exemption from emissions testing, and; insurance requirements for certain classic vehicle special plates.

**Authority:** NRS 481.051 (Powers and duties of the Director: Generally; delegation) and Assembly Bill 349, Chapter 363; Section 7 subsection 3, and Section 9 subsection 3.

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**Section 1. Chapter 445B.499 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the following language.**

1. The fee for the initial issuance and biennial renewal of an inspector's license is \$25.
2. If an inspector who is employed by a test station and has paid the fee required by subsection 1 wishes to be licensed at one or more additional locations of ~~a that~~ test station, the fee for the issuance and biennial renewal of an inspector's license for each additional location is ~~\$10~~*\$2*.
3. The fee for the transfer of an inspector's license is ~~\$2~~ *\$10*.

**Section 2. Chapter 445B.592 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the following language.**

The provisions of subsection 3 of NAC 445B.576 and NAC 445B.593 to 445B.596, inclusive, do not apply to any:

1. Motorcycle or moped.
2. Motor vehicle which is subject to prorated registration pursuant to NRS 706.801 to 706.861, inclusive, and is not based in this State.
3. New motor vehicle until the ~~third~~ *fourth* registration of the vehicle.

4. Motor vehicle permanently converted from gasoline to propane, compressed natural gas (CNG), methane or butane as a fuel.

5. Motor vehicle with a model year before 1968.

6. Heavy-duty motor vehicle which has a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of more than 14,000 pounds and which is powered by a diesel engine.

7. Trimobile, as defined in NRS 482.129, that meets the definition of a motorcycle set forth in 40 C.F.R. § 86.402-78 or 86.402-98.

**Section 3. Chapter 485 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section.**

- 1. For vehicles registered with an Old Timer, Classic Rod or Classic Vehicle special plate, the registered owner must have proof satisfactory to the Department that the vehicle is covered by insurance that is designed or designated specifically for classic or antique vehicles, or includes an endorsement that is designed or designated specifically for classic vehicles or antique vehicles*
- 2. The provisions of this section becomes effective on January 1, 2023.*
