DRAFT LANGUAGE - CGR 508 NAC 502 ANTLER POINTS AND SPIKE ELK DEFINED

NAC 502.006 “Antler point” defined. (NRS 501.105, 501.181) “Antler point” means a projection which is at least 1 inch in length with the length exceeding the width of its base. *For mule deer only, the first point on the main beam is excluded, commonly known as the eye guard.*

NAC 502.104 “Spike elk” defined. (NRS 501.105, 501.181) “Spike elk” means any antlered elk having not more than *three antler points* on either antler.

NAC 502.1045 “Spike elk only” defined. (NRS 501.105, 501.181) “Spike elk only” means, in a designation of elk that may be taken during an open season, only antlered elk having not more than *three antler points on either antler.*
