1 **Chapter 484B is hereby added to the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC).**

2 **Sec. 1.**

3 ***“Highway” defined***

4 *“Highway” has the meaning ascribed to it in Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 484A.095.*

5 **Sec. 2**

6 ***Temporary Closure of Highways***

7 *“Open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular traffic” as used in NRS 484A.095*
8 *does not include periods of temporary closure to vehicular traffic of any way dedicated to a*
9 *public authority.*

10 **Sec. 3.**

11 ***Special Event Temporary Commercial Advertising***

12 *A public authority may permit a person to place or maintain, a temporary sign, signal,*
13 *marking, banner, placard, billboard, or other form of outdoor advertisement on a highway or*
14 *bridge, for a special event during times when a highway is not open to the use of the public for*
15 *vehicular traffic, for a period not to exceed fourteen (14) consecutive calendar days.*

16 *“Special event” as used in this section, means a temporary event, including, without*
17 *limitation, a sporting event, concert, festival, or competition.*

18 **Sec. 4**

19 ***Special Event Temporary Commercial Advertising Requirements***

20 *Temporary commercial advertising for a special event that is affixed to poles,*
21 *buildings, fences, gates, or any structures located within twenty (20) feet of a highway, or*
22 *a bridge over a highway, that will be intermittently closed and reopened to the use of the*
23 *public for purpose of vehicular traffic prior to, during the pendency of, or during clean up*
24 *of the special event, must be obscured or converted in a manner that it does not constitute*

1 *a hazard upon or prevent the safe use of the highway during times when the highway is open to*
2 *vehicular traffic. This provision does not apply to structures on which permanent or long-term*
3 *advertising is allowed pursuant to NRS Chapters 484.*
