## Digest for Adopted Regulation R 040-13

Existing law requires the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine to adopt regulations governing the licensure of physician's assistants. (NRS 633.434) Under existing regulations, an applicant for a license as a physician assistant is required to include certain information when submitting his or her application. (NAC 633.283) **Section 1** of this regulation revises these provisions by adding a requirement that an applicant must: (1) submit certain educational transcripts; (2) submit proof of certain certifications; and (3) provide certain documentation to prove the applicant's citizenship or lawful presence in the United States.

Under existing law, the Board is required to charge and collect certain licensure fees. (NRS 633.501) **Section 2** of this regulation reduces the annual license renewal fee for osteopathic physicians from \$500 to \$450 and the annual license renewal fee for physician assistants from \$400 to \$250.
