

## Digest for Adopted Regulation R\_084-13

Existing law requires the State Board of Education to adopt regulations establishing the course of study and the grade levels for which the course of study applies for the subject of science. (NRS 389.018, 389.0185)

Existing regulations establish the course of study for the subject of science which applies for the grade levels of kindergarten through 2nd grade, 3rd through 5th grade, 6th through 8th grade and 9th through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. (NAC 389.244, 389.2939, 389.411, 389.4915) **Sections 2, 3 and 6** of this regulation establish the course of study for the subject of science which applies for the grade levels of kindergarten and 1st grade and revise the course of study which applies for second grade, respectively. **Sections 4, 5 and 7** of this regulation establish the course of study for the subject of science which applies for the grade levels of 3rd and 4th grades and revise the course of study which applies for the 5th grade, respectively. **Section 8** of this regulation revises the course of study which applies for the 6th through 8th grades. **Section 10** of this regulation revises the course of study which applies for the 9th through 12<sup>th</sup> grades.

Existing regulations establish the course of study for certain elective courses in science taken in high school. (NAC 389.492, 389.494, 389.496, 389.498) **Section 11** of this regulation repeals those regulations.
