## LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF ADOPTED REGULATIONS--NAC 576.300-576.440 Informational Statement LCB File No. R-086-15

The new federal requirements under the Food Safety Modernization Act mandate the ability to trace food sources in the event of a food borne illness event. We have no way to do that without registering producers of products destined for human consumption.

The fee for added registrants for Producers Certificates was waived. The \$50.00 fee that applies to our Producers Certificate holders now applies to Produce Vendors who market products in Nevada. We expect fewer than 50 registrants annually. Revenue generated will be used to offset the cost of registration enforcement.
