I, Kristina L. Swallow, P.E., being the duly appointed Director, do hereby certify that, to the best of my knowledge or belief:

1. Impact to Small Business

The purpose of this proposed regulation is to revise and update provisions pertaining to permitting the travel of over-dimensional vehicles and align specified sections of NAC 484D with best practices and standards in the trucking industry.

These amendments to the regulations are designed to keep pace with industry standards and are not anticipated to increase costs. Businesses in the trucking industry were actively involved in the discussion and drafting of these amendments. Comments received from small businesses were positive, with no indication that the proposed regulations would impose an economic burden on small businesses.

2. The proposed regulation is not likely to impose a direct and significant burden upon a small business or directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a small business.

This regulation governs the issuance of permits by the Nevada Department of Transportation, which authorize days and times of travel for over-dimensional vehicles. Additionally, these regulations clarify the requirements to survey routes and defines the circumstances in which pilot cars are to accompany certain oversized and overweight vehicles on highways, interstates, and roadways throughout the State of Nevada.

The Department has determined that these regulations are neither likely to impose a direct or significant burden upon a small business, nor will it restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business.
