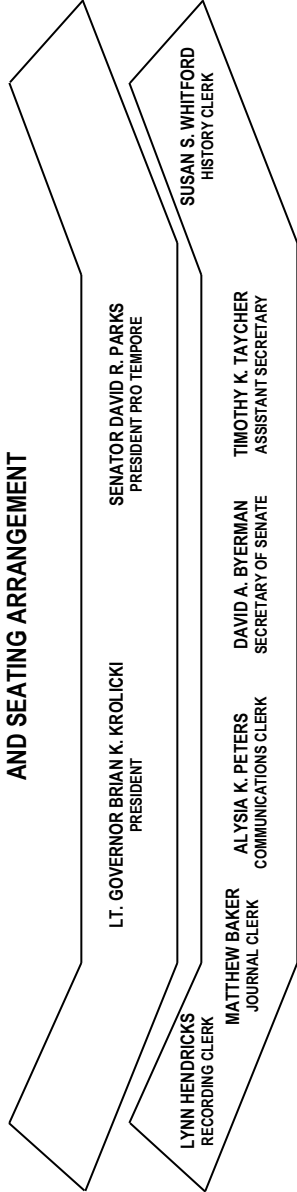

SENATE BILL

S.B. 1—Committee of the Whole, Sep. 10.

Summary—Revises provisions relating to commerce. (BDR 32-14) Fiscal Note:
Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact. Effect on the State: Yes.

Sep. 10—Read first time. Referred to Committee of the Whole. To printer.

Sep. 11—From printer. To committee. From committee: Amend, and do pass as amended. Declared an emergency measure under the Constitution. Read third time. Amended. (Amend. No. 1.) To printer. From printer. To engrossment. Engrossed. First reprint. Read third time. Passed, as amended. Title approved. (Yeas: 21, Nays: None.) To Assembly. In Assembly. Read first time. Referred to Committee of the Whole. To committee. From committee: Considered. Declared an emergency measure under the Constitution. Read third time. Passed. Title approved. (Yeas: 39, Nays: None, Excused: 2, Vacant: 1.) To Senate. In Senate. To enrollment. Enrolled and delivered to Governor. Approved by the Governor. Chapter 4.

Effective September 11, 2014. Section 38 of this act expires by limitation on December 31, 2014. Sections 21 and 22 of this act expire by limitation on June 30, 2023. Sections 2 to 20, inclusive, 23 to 37, inclusive, 39 and 40 of this act expire by limitation on June 30, 2036.
