[S.B. 41](#) (R1) Revises certain provisions governing the regulation of certain providers of telecommunication services by the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. (BDR 58-324)

[S.B. 252](#) (R1) Revises provisions relating to the portfolio standard for providers of electric service. (BDR 58-775)

[S.B. 268](#) (R1) Requires a provider of wireless telecommunications to provide call location information to a law enforcement agency in certain emergency situations. (BDR 58-623)

[S.B. 329](#) (R1) Creates the Account for Clean Energy Loans. (BDR 58-861)
