[A.B. 72](#) Revises provisions relating to the Nevada State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners. (BDR 54-189)

[A.B. 83](#) Revises provisions governing certain disbursements of money from escrow accounts. (BDR 54-686)

[A.B. 170](#) Revises provisions relating to the advanced practice of nursing. (BDR 54-778)
