ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Honoring the  
contributions of former members of the Nevada  
Legislature.

- 1 WHEREAS, Section 1 of Article 4 of the Nevada Constitution
- 2 provides that the legislative authority of the State of Nevada is
- 3 vested in a Senate and Assembly which shall be designated as the
- 4 Legislature of the State of Nevada; and
- 5 WHEREAS, From the time the first Nevada Territorial
- 6 Legislature met in 1861 until the present day, over 2,100 Legislators
- 7 have served the people of Nevada; and



1 WHEREAS, The Legislature is comprised of 21 Senators and 42  
2 Assemblymen, each representing the geographic and cultural  
3 diversity of this State; and

4 WHEREAS, Nevada is one of only six states that has a true  
5 citizen legislature, with its members representing many different  
6 occupations, including ranchers, miners, doctors, school teachers,  
7 plumbers, lawyers, casino dealers, business owners and retirees; and

8 WHEREAS, Such Legislators have ranged in age from 21 to 81  
9 years of age, and have served terms from as little as a few days up to  
10 40 years; and

11 WHEREAS, Each of member of the Nevada Legislature has  
12 brought his or her unique perspective, understanding and expertise  
13 to this role, reflecting the rich and varied life experiences of such  
14 persons; and

15 WHEREAS, Over the last 156 years, the members of the Nevada  
16 Legislature have been asked to solve complex and difficult policy  
17 issues, making vital decisions that have profoundly affected the  
18 lives of the residents of this State and shaping the future of this  
19 State; and

20 WHEREAS, Many members of the Nevada Legislature have gone  
21 on to serve as United States Senators and Representatives,  
22 Governors and state and federal judges, as well as becoming leaders  
23 in commerce and various other professions; now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
25 SENATE CONCURRING, That April 27, 2017, is designated as  
26 Alumni Day at the Nevada Legislature; and be it further

27 RESOLVED, That on this day we honor all the former Legislators  
28 who have served as members of this great institution and reflect on  
29 the sacrifices they made to serve the people of this State.
