

SENATE BILL NO. 92—SENATOR HARDY

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the Task Force on Alzheimer’s Disease. (BDR S-270)

AN ACT relating to public health; removing the prospective expiration of the Task Force on Alzheimer’s Disease; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Existing law establishes the Task Force on Alzheimer’s Disease within the  
2 Department of Health and Human Services. (NRS 439.5083) The Task Force: (1)  
3 develops, reviews, revises and monitors the implementation of a state plan to  
4 address Alzheimer’s disease; and (2) researches and reviews other issues relevant  
5 to Alzheimer’s disease. (NRS 439.5085) The Task Force is currently scheduled to  
6 expire by limitation on June 30, 2017. (Section 10 of chapter 409, Statutes of  
7 Nevada 2013, p. 2256) This bill removes that expiration date, making the Task  
8 Force permanent.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Section 10 of chapter 409, Statutes of Nevada 2013,  
2 at page 2256, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 Sec. 10. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013 . ~~†~~  
4 ~~and expires by limitation on June 30, 2017.†~~

5 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
