The part-time Executive Director ("ED") will have to increase her hours by approximately 4-5 hours a week to work on the regulations required by the BDR to include licensees from other jurisdictions as well as conduct license verifications from the other jurisdictions.

The ED position is currently a part-time position requiring approximately 10-20 hours per week with a monthly payment of \$1700, making her hourly rate approximately \$26.15. By increasing the work hours by an average of 4.5 hours per week @ \$26.15 per hour, the ED's salary would have to be increased by \$509.93 per month or \$6119 per year. (The hourly rate calculations are based upon 52 weeks per year and then divided by 12 months.)

Comment: In section 7 of BDR 54-229 Regulatory Bodies depending on how “rejection” is defined, this proposed requirement could significantly impact the Plant Industry Division financially.

This division licenses approximately 1,100 production nurseries, retail nurseries, landscape companies, peddlers and brokers to sell nursery stock annually. On average ten or less applications are denied. Our Pest Control Operator (PCO) program licenses approximately 570 companies and 2,100 individuals to conduct pest control.

Depending on how “rejection” is defined the fiscal impact could be great. The PCO company license could be rejected for a number of reasons such as lack of or insufficient insurance, or failure to appoint a qualified primary principal; which could be the result of the individual not passing a background check or not having the proper work history experience. The NDA averages 60 of these types of rejections annually. All individuals who apply or reapply annually to conduct pest control are required to pass an examination or successfully obtain a certain number of continuing education units (CEU). If the individual does not meet this criteria their application is rejected and the NDA averages 910 of these types of rejections annually. If this form of “rejection” meets the definition proposed in BDR 54-229 Regulatory Bodies the fiscal impact could be extremely significant to the division.

Based on the requirements outlined in the BDR we estimate that it would take roughly two hours to track each individual rejection and compile a quarterly report. If “rejection” does not include examinations or CEU’s the fiscal impact would be about 140 hrs of work for an Administrative Assistant 2 to compile. If exams and CEU were included the fiscal impact could be an additional 1,820 hrs of work totaling 1,960 hrs of work. 2080 hrs represents a full FTE, 1960 hrs equals .9423 FTE, therefore costs are estimated at 1 FTE. Costs: Year 1 = \$49,271, Year 2 = \$48,197.

Because the General Services Division (GSD) has no way to estimate the number of individuals this requirement could cover a definitive cost estimate cannot be provided at this time. The cumulative impact to the division's Criminal History Repository resulting from applicant submission of fingerprint based background checks must be considered. GSD requests to return to the Nevada Legislature's Interim Finance Committee in the 2017-2019 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing. Also, if this bill is enacted the FBI will need to review and approve the language pursuant to Public Law 92-544 as a condition of releasing its criminal history records.
