SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing interscholastic activities. (BDR 34-517)

AN ACT relating to interscholastic activities; requiring any board formed to govern the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association to include at least three members who are parents or guardians of pupils who participate in a sanctioned sport; requiring any advisory board to a governing board to include at least three members who are pupils currently participating in a sanctioned sport; establishing certain requirements relating to the residency and terms of such members who are parents, guardians or pupils; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Under existing law, the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association controls, supervises
2 and regulates all interscholastic athletic events and other interscholastic events in public
3 schools. (NRS 385B.050) This bill requires any board formed to govern the Nevada
4 Interscholastic Activities Association to include at least three members who are parents or
5 guardians of pupils who participate in a sanctioned sport. This bill also requires any advisory
6 board formed to advise a governing board to include at least three members who are pupils
7 currently participating in a sanctioned sport. Such members are required to fulfill certain
8 residency requirements and are prohibited from being employees of or immediate family
9 members of employees of a school district ~~H~~, **charter school or private school**. This bill
10 also requires that the terms of such members be consistent in duration with the terms of other
11 members of the board and be served in full-year increments during any year that a pupil who
12 is a member or a pupil whose parent or guardian is a member participates in one or more
13 sanctioned sports.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 385B.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 385B.050 *1.* The county school district trustees may form a nonprofit
3 association, to be known as the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association,
4 composed of all of the school districts of the State for the purposes of controlling,
5 supervising and regulating all interscholastic athletic events and other
6 interscholastic events in the public schools. This section does not prohibit a public
7 school, which is authorized by the Association to do so, from joining an association
8 formed for similar purposes in another state.

9 *2. Any board formed to govern the Nevada Interscholastic Activities*
10 *Association must include at least three members who are parents or guardians of*
11 *pupils who participate in a sanctioned sport. Of the members who are parents or*
12 *guardians of pupils who participate in a sanctioned sport:*

13 *(a) At least one member must be a resident of a county whose population is*
14 *700,000 or more;*

15 *(b) At least one member must be a resident of a county whose population is*
16 *100,000 more but less than 700,000;*

17 *(c) At least one member must be a resident of a county whose population is*
18 *less than 100,000; and*

19 *(d) Each member must not be an employee of or an immediate family*
20 *member of an employee of a school district ~~or~~, charter school or private school.*

21 *3. Any advisory board formed to advise a governing board of the Nevada*
22 *Interscholastic Activities Association must include at least three members who*
23 *are pupils currently participating in a sanctioned sport. Of the members who are*
24 *pupils currently participating in a sanctioned sport:*

25 *(a) At least one member must be a resident of a county whose population is*
26 *700,000 or more;*

27 *(b) At least one member must be a resident of a county whose population is*
28 *100,000 or more but less than 700,000;*

29 *(c) At least one member must be a resident of a county whose population is*
30 *less than 100,000; and*

31 *(d) Each member must not be an employee of or an immediate family*
32 *member of an employee of a school district.*

33 *4. The terms of each member of a board formed to govern the Nevada*
34 *Interscholastic Activities Association who is a parent or guardian of a pupil who*
35 *participates in a sanctioned sport and each pupil who is a member of an advisory*
36 *board to such a governing board must be consistent in duration with the terms of*
37 *other members of the applicable board and be served in full-year increments*
38 *during any year that a pupil who is a member or a pupil whose parent or*
39 *guardian is a member participates in one or more sanctioned sports.*

40 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2022.
