SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the eligibility requirements for participation in courses for an adult to earn a high school diploma. (BDR 34-653)

AN ACT relating to education; requiring the Department of Education to adopt regulations relating to the eligibility of certain persons to enroll in courses for an adult to earn a high school diploma; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Under existing regulations, the Superintendent of Public Instruction or the State Board of  
2 Education may approve an application by a school district to operate an adult high school  
3 program. Existing regulations authorize enrollment in an adult high school program for a  
4 person who: (1) is at least 18 years of age or is eligible for participation in the statewide  
5 program of education for incarcerated persons established pursuant to existing law; (2) has not  
6 received a high school diploma; and (3) is not currently enrolled in high school. (NRS  
7 388H.020; NAC 387.190, 388H.040) This bill requires the Department of Education to adopt  
8 regulations that require the board of trustees of a school district that offers courses for an adult  
9 to earn a high school diploma to allow enrollment in such courses by a person who has not  
10 received a high school diploma and: (1) is at least 18 years of age or is eligible for  
11 participation in the statewide program of education for incarcerated persons; or (2) is at least  
12 17 years of age and has ~~completed~~ **attended** at least 4 years of high school.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 392 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new  
2 section to read as follows:  
3 *The Department shall adopt regulations that require the board of trustees of a*  
4 *school district that offers courses which are approved by the Department as*  
5 *meeting the requirements for an adult to earn a high school diploma to allow*

1 *enrollment in such courses by a person who has not received a high school*  
2 *diploma and:*

3 *1. Is at least 18 years of age or meets the requirements for participation in*  
4 *the statewide program of education for incarcerated persons established pursuant*  
5 *to NRS 388H.020; or*

6 *2. Is at least 17 years of age and has ~~completed~~ attended at least 4 years of*  
7 *high school.*

8 **Sec. 2.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any additional  
9 expenses of a local government that are related to the provisions of this act.

10 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2021.
