SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the Advisory Board on Outdoor Recreation. (BDR 35-344)

AN ACT relating to outdoor recreation; increasing the membership of the Advisory Board on Outdoor Recreation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

Existing law creates the Advisory Board on Outdoor Recreation, consisting of 11 voting members, to advise the Administrator of the Division of Outdoor Recreation in the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources on any matter concerning outdoor recreation in Nevada. (NRS 407A.575) This bill increases the membership of the Advisory Board by adding: (1) ~~the Executive Director of~~ **one member nominated by the Board of Directors of** the Nevada Association of Counties **and appointed by the Governor** as a voting member; (2) one representative of the United States Department of the Interior as a nonvoting member; and (3) one representative of the United States Department of Agriculture as a nonvoting member.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** NRS 407A.575 is hereby amended to read as follows:

407A.575 1. There is hereby created the Advisory Board on Outdoor Recreation composed of:

(a) *The following 12 voting members:*

(1) The Lieutenant Governor or his or her designee;

~~(b)~~ (2) The Director or his or her designee;

~~(c)~~ (3) The Director of the Department of Tourism and Cultural Affairs or his or her designee;

~~(d)~~ (4) The Executive Director of the Office of Economic Development or his or her designee;

~~(e)~~ (5) The Director of the Department of Wildlife or his or her designee;

1 ~~[(6)]~~ (6) The Administrator of the Division of State Parks of the Department;

2 ~~[(6)]~~ (7) The Chair of the Nevada Indian Commission;

3 (8) ~~[(The Executive Director)]~~ One member appointed by the Governor  
4 from a list of nominees submitted by the Board of Directors of the Nevada  
5 Association of Counties, or its successor organization ~~[( )]~~, who:

6 (I) Resides in a county whose population is less than 100,000; and

7 (II) Has professional expertise or possesses demonstrated knowledge  
8 in outdoor recreation, natural resources management and economic development  
9 in this State; and

11 (9) **Four** members ~~[(who must be)]~~ appointed by the Governor from a list of  
12 nominees submitted by the Lieutenant Governor and the Director ~~[( )]~~ **as follows:**

25 2. The Lieutenant Governor or his or her designee shall:

26 (a) Serve as Chair of the Advisory Board; and

27 (b) Appoint a member of the Advisory Board to serve as Vice Chair of the  
28 Advisory Board.

29 3. The Advisory Board shall meet at such times and places as are specified by  
30 a call of the Chair but not less than once a year. ~~[(Six)]~~ **A majority of the voting**
