SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the Advisory Board on Outdoor Recreation. (BDR 35-344)

AN ACT relating to outdoor recreation; increasing the membership of the Advisory Board on Outdoor Recreation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Existing law creates the Advisory Board on Outdoor Recreation, consisting of  
2 11 voting members, to advise the Administrator of the Division of Outdoor  
3 Recreation in the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources on any  
4 matter concerning outdoor recreation in Nevada. (NRS 407A.575) This bill  
5 increases the membership of the Advisory Board by adding: (1) the Executive  
6 Director of the Nevada Association of Counties as a voting member; (2) one  
7 representative of the United States Department of the Interior as a nonvoting  
8 member; and (3) one representative of the United States Department of Agriculture  
9 as a nonvoting member.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 407A.575 is hereby amended to read as  
2 follows:

3 407A.575 1. There is hereby created the Advisory Board on  
4 Outdoor Recreation composed of:

5 (a) *The following 12 voting members:*

6 (1) The Lieutenant Governor or his or her designee;

7 ~~(b)~~ (2) The Director or his or her designee;

2 Cultural Affairs or his or her designee;

6 her designee;

10 (8) *The Executive Director of the Nevada Association of*  
11 *Counties or its successor organization;* and

13 (9) *Four* members ~~[who must be]~~ appointed by the Governor  
14 from a list of nominees submitted by the Lieutenant Governor and  
15 the Director ~~[-]~~ *as follows:*

17 ~~[(2)]~~ (II) A representative of conservation interests;

18 ~~[(3)]~~ (III) A person with experience in and knowledge of

21 public health.

22 (b) *The following two nonvoting members who must be*  
23 *appointed by the Administrator of the Division of Outdoor*  
24 *Recreation or his or her designee, subject to the approval of the*  
25 *Director:*

26 (1) *A representative of the United States Department of the*  
27 *Interior from the Bureau of Land Management, National Park*  
28 *Service or United States Fish and Wildlife Service; and*

29 (2) *A representative of the United States Department of*  
30 *Agriculture from the United States Forest Service or Rural*  
31 *Development.*

32 2. The Lieutenant Governor or his or her designee shall:

33 (a) Serve as Chair of the Advisory Board; and

34 (b) Appoint a member of the Advisory Board to serve as Vice  
35 Chair of the Advisory Board.

36 3. The Advisory Board shall meet at such times and places as  
37 are specified by a call of the Chair but not less than once a year.

1       4. The Advisory Board shall advise the Administrator on any  
2 matter concerning outdoor recreation in this State.

3       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2021.
