**SUMMARY**—Makes appropriations to the State Board of Parole Commissioners for the replacement of computer hardware, software and related equipment and licenses to upgrade a computer operating system. (BDR S-1158)

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AN ACT making appropriations to the State Board of Parole Commissioners for the replacement of computer hardware, software and related equipment and licenses to upgrade a computer operating system; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 2 Fund to the State Board of Parole Commissioners the sum of
- 3 \$66,169 for the replacement of computer hardware and associated
- 4 software.
- 5     **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 6 Fund to the State Board of Parole Commissioners the sum of
- 7 \$45,556 for the replacement of switches, firewall and router
- 8 equipment.
- 9     **Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
- 10 Fund to the State Board of Parole Commissioners the sum of \$739
- 11 for licenses to upgrade the computer operating system.



1       **Sec. 4.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by  
2 sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act must not be committed for expenditure  
3 after June 30, 2025, by the entity to which the appropriation is made  
4 or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or  
5 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
6 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
7 after September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money  
8 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently  
9 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General  
10 Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

11       **Sec. 5.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
