ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION—Adding former Assemblyman Peter “Pete” Livermore to the Assembly Wall of Distinction.

1 WHEREAS, The Assembly of the Legislature of the State of
2 Nevada has established a Wall of Distinction for those past
3 members of the Assembly selected by leadership who served with
4 great distinction and who made exemplary contributions to the State
5 of Nevada; and

6 WHEREAS, Peter “Pete” Livermore spent his career in public
7 service tending to his community, improving the quality of life for
8 generations of Nevadans through his work championing youth
9 sports, safeguarding the Carson River watershed and fostering
10 investments in the health and well-being of his constituents; and

11 WHEREAS, Pete’s dedication to Nevada began after meeting his
12 future wife, Laurie Bird, on a visit to Carson City while serving in
13 the United States Marine Corps; and

14 WHEREAS, After moving to the Silver State and working as a
15 mail carrier in Carson City, Pete embraced entrepreneurship,
16 eventually owning three A&W Restaurants that became popular
17 with local residents and State Legislators; and

18 WHEREAS, After several years in the private sector, Pete chose
19 to devote his life to public service, sitting on numerous boards and
20 commissions affecting public health, land use planning and quality
21 of life for seniors, in addition to serving 2 years as Mayor Pro
22 Tempore of Carson City; and

23 WHEREAS, Pete’s sense of duty extended to coaching youth
24 sports and serving as the president of the Carson City Youth Sports
25 Association for 25 years; and



1 WHEREAS, During his 12-year tenure on the Carson City Board
2 of Supervisors, one of Pete's proudest achievements was developing
3 the Edmonds Sports Complex, a hub for youth sports which has
4 since been renamed in his honor; and

5 WHEREAS, In 2010, Pete's passion for serving his community
6 was put to work at the state level after winning election to the
7 Nevada Assembly, where he advocated on behalf of the constituents
8 of District No. 40 for two regular sessions; and

9 WHEREAS, While in the Assembly, Pete led the charge to
10 preserve the 150-year-old Nevada State Prison, advancing signature
11 legislation that affirmed its historical significance and paved the
12 way not only for its revitalization as a state museum but also for its
13 inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places; and

14 WHEREAS, Pete served in the Assembly with honor and
15 distinction until his passing on October 20, 2014, and is
16 remembered for placing the needs of his constituents and the people
17 of Nevada first; and

18 WHEREAS, Pete was posthumously honored by the Carson
19 Water Subconservancy District for his exemplary work protecting
20 the Carson River watershed, including his furtherance of the Carson
21 City Quality of Life Initiative, which expanded protection of the
22 watershed and public access to outdoor recreation; and

23 WHEREAS, In addition to the measureless dedication he paid to
24 his family, Pete is distinguished for having lived a life of
25 meaningful service, for drawing upon his intelligence, wit and
26 generosity to strengthen his community and better the State of
27 Nevada; now, therefore, be it

28 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, That
29 Peter "Pete" Livermore is hereby added to the Assembly Wall of
30 Distinction; and be it further

31 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and
32 transmit a copy of this resolution to Pete's beloved wife, Laurie, and
33 their children, Richard, Sheri and Jackie; and be it further

34 RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon
35 adoption.
