A.B. No. 32—Makes various changes relating to criminal justice. (BDR 14-263)



Section 2.7 of Assembly Bill No. 32 First Reprint is hereby amended as follows:

1 **Sec. 2.7.** NRS 176.014 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 176.014 1. The Nevada Local Justice Reinvestment Coordinating Council is
3 hereby created. The Council consists of:

4 (a) One member from each county in this State whose population is less than
5 100,000; and

6 (b) Two members from each county in this State whose population is 100,000
7 or more.

8 2. Each member of the Council must be appointed by the governing body of
9 the applicable county and must meet any qualifications adopted by the Sentencing
10 Commission pursuant to subsection ~~7.1~~ 8. The Chair of the Sentencing
11 Commission shall appoint the Chair of the Council from among the members of the
12 Council.

13 3. The Council shall:

14 (a) Advise the Sentencing Commission on matters related to any legislation,
15 regulations, rules, budgetary changes and all other actions needed to implement the
16 provisions of chapter 633, Statutes of Nevada 2019, as they relate to local
17 governments;

18 (b) Identify county-level programming and treatment needs for persons
19 involved in the criminal justice system for the purpose of reducing recidivism;

20 (c) Make recommendations to the Sentencing Commission regarding grants to
21 local governments, courts and nonprofit organizations from the State General
22 Fund;

23 (d) Oversee the implementation of local grants;

24 (e) Create performance measures to assess the effectiveness of the grants; and

25 (f) Identify opportunities for collaboration with the Department of Health and
26 Human Services at the state and county level for treatment services and funding.

27 4. Each member of the Council serves a term of 2 years. Members may be
28 reappointed for additional terms of 2 years in the same manner as the original
29 appointments. Any vacancy occurring in the membership of the Council must be
30 filled in the same manner as the original appointment not later than 30 days after
31 the vacancy occurs.

32 5. While engaged in the business of the Council, to the extent of legislative
33 appropriation, each member of the Council is entitled to receive the per diem
34 allowance and travel expenses provided for state officers and employees generally.

35 6. *The Council may accept any gift, donation, bequest, grant or other*
36 *source of money for the purpose of carrying out its duties pursuant to this*
37 *section.*

38 7. To the extent of legislative appropriation, the Sentencing Commission shall
39 provide the Council with such staff as is necessary to carry out the duties of the
40 Council pursuant to this section.

41 ~~7.1~~ 8. The Sentencing Commission may adopt any qualifications that a
42 person must meet before being appointed as a member of the Council.
