AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the Department of Health and Human Services for an unanticipated revenue shortfall and an increase in operating costs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1       **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
- 2       Division of Public and Behavioral Health of the Department of Health and Human
- 3       Services the sum of ~~[\$589,999]~~ **\$471,798** for an unanticipated revenue shortfall and
- 4       an increase in operating costs. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by
- 5       section 17 of chapter 310, Statutes of Nevada 2021, at page 1804.
- 6       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
