SUMMARY—Makes appropriations for various purposes relating to health, education, employment and other community services. (BDR S-1225)

AN ACT making appropriations for various purposes relating to health, education, employment and other community services; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the sum of ~~[\$750,000]~~ **\$500,000** for allocation to the International Gaming Institute of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, for the “Expanding the Leaderverse” initiative to increase the diversity of the leadership in the gaming industry.

2. Allocation of the money appropriated by subsection 1 is contingent upon matching money being obtained by the International Gaming Institute, including, without limitation, gifts, grants and donations to the International Gaming Institute from private and public sources of money other than the appropriation made by subsection 1. The Interim Finance Committee shall not direct the transfer of any portion of money from the appropriation made by subsection 1 until the International Gaming Institute submits to the Committee proof satisfactory to the Committee that matching money in an equivalent amount has been committed.

Sec. 1.5. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the sum of ~~[\$5,500,000]~~ **\$2,500,000** for allocation to the nonprofit corporation formed to establish an art museum in Las Vegas, Nevada, upon a showing to the Committee:

1. That the corporation has been incorporated under the laws of this State as a nonprofit corporation; and

2. That the purpose of the corporation is to establish an art museum in Las Vegas, Nevada.

1 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to United
2 Way of Northern Nevada the sum of \$1,200,000 for its activities related to public
3 health, education and improving economic mobility.

4 **Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
5 Foundation for an Independent Tomorrow the sum of \$2,000,000 for its activities
6 related to vocational training, job preparation, education and employment services.

7 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
8 Culinary Academy of Las Vegas the sum of \$15,000,000 for its capital
9 improvement plan.

10 **Sec. 5.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to A
11 Source of Joy Theatricals, Inc. the sum of \$1,000,000 for the Legacy Theatre
12 Project.

13 **Sec. 6.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Food
14 Bank of Northern Nevada the sum of \$2,000,000 to address food insecurities of
15 residents of this State.

16 **Sec. 7.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
17 Three Square Food Bank the sum of \$2,000,000 to address food insecurities of
18 residents of this State.

19 **Sec. 8.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Boys
20 Town Nevada the sum of \$250,000 for its programs and services.

21 **Sec. 9.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Foster
22 Kinship the sum of \$750,000 for the Kinship Navigator Program.

23 **Sec. 10.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
24 HopeLink of Southern Nevada the sum of \$2,000,000 for wraparound services for
25 families at risk of homelessness.

26 **Sec. 11.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
27 Catholic Charities of Southern Nevada the sum of \$2,000,000 for the Meals on
28 Wheels Program.

29 **Sec. 12.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
30 Candlelighters Childhood Cancer Foundation of Nevada the sum of \$1,000,000 for
31 the provision of assistance to children affected by cancer and their families.

32 **Sec. 13.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Legal
33 Aid Center of Southern Nevada the sum of \$250,000 for programs and services
34 relating to tenants' rights.

35 **Sec. 14.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
36 United Way of Southern Nevada the sum of \$1,200,000 for its activities related to
37 public health, education and improving economic mobility.

38 **Sec. 15.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
39 Goodwill of Southern Nevada the sum of \$1,500,000 for transforming workforce
40 development initiatives.

41 **Sec. 16.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
42 Special Olympics Nevada the sum of ~~(\$500,000)~~ **\$250,000** for its programs.

43 **Sec. 17.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Friends
44 in Service Helping the sum of \$3,000,000 for a capital improvement project.

45 **Sec. 18.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
46 United Labor Agency of Nevada, Inc. the sum of \$500,000 for providing
47 community services.

48 **Sec. 19.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
49 Community Health Alliance the sum of \$4,500,000 for a capital improvement
50 project.

51 **Sec. 20.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
52 Chicanos Por La Causa Nevada, Inc. the sum of \$10,000 for economic
53 empowerment of low-income persons.

1 **Sec. 21.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
2 Latino Youth Leadership Foundation the sum of \$10,000 to assist high school
3 pupils with leadership training and development.

4 **Sec. 22.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
5 Nevada Latino Bar Association the sum of \$10,000 to provide assistance for
6 preparation for the admission test for law school.

7 **Sec. 23.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Project
8 150 the sum of \$10,000 to provide support to homeless, displaced and
9 disadvantaged high school pupils.

10 **Sec. 24.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
11 South-Asian Women's Alliance of Nevada the sum of \$10,000 to bridge the gap
12 between South-Asian communities and resources in Southern Nevada.

13 **Sec. 25.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Leaders
14 in Training the sum of ~~(\$10,000)~~ **\$250,000** for educational training, support and
15 programming for first-generation college students.

16 **Sec. 26.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
17 Uplift Foundation of Nevada the sum of \$10,000 for its programs and services.

18 **Sec. 27.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to The
19 Foundation Christian Center the sum of \$10,000 for its food programs.

20 **Sec. 28.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to King of
21 Jewels the sum of \$10,000 for its programs.

22 **Sec. 29.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to The
23 Cupcake Girls the sum of \$ 10,000 for services for persons affected by sex
24 trafficking.

28 **Sec. 31.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
29 T.U.L.I.P.S. (Teaching and Uniting Ladies to Inspire Positive Success) the sum of
30 \$25,000 for its programs.

31 **Sec. 32.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
32 Gentleman By Choice Community Development Corporation the sum of \$25,000
33 for its programs.

34 **Sec. 33.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Spread
35 the Word Nevada the sum of \$500,000 for providing books to advance childhood
36 literacy.

37 **Sec. 34.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
38 Northern Nevada HOPES the sum of \$2,000,000 for providing primary and
39 behavioral health care services.

40 **Sec. 35.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
41 Pioneer Center for the Performing Arts the sum of \$1,000,000 for a renovation
42 project.

43 **Sec. 36.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Nevada
44 Partners, Inc. the sum of \$1,000,000 to assist with its summer and educational
45 program.

46 **Sec. 37.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
47 Nevada Small Business Development Center the sum of \$1,000,000 for its
48 programs.

49 **Sec. 38.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
50 Nevada State Prison Preservation Society the sum of \$1,000,000 for a capital
51 improvement project.

52 **Sec. 39.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
53 Boys & Girls Clubs of Southern Nevada the sum of \$250,000 for its programs.

1 **Sec. 40.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
2 Boys & Girls Club of Truckee Meadows the sum of ~~[\$100,000]~~ **\$250,000** for its
3 programs.

4 **Sec. 41.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to ~~the~~
5 ~~Nevada Blind Children's Foundation]~~ **Opportunity Village** the sum of ~~[\$750,000]~~
6 **\$250,000** for its programs and services.

7 **Sec. 42.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
8 Urban Chamber Community Development Corporation the sum of \$100,000 for its
9 Nevada Small Business Development Center.

10 **Sec. 43.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to The
11 Neon Museum the sum of ~~[\$2,000,000]~~ **\$1,000,000** for a capital improvement
12 project.

13 **Sec. 44.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
14 Economic Opportunity Board of Clark County the sum of \$100,000 for its
15 programs.

16 **Sec. 45.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
17 Nevada Partnership for Homeless Youth the sum of ~~[\$25,000]~~ **\$50,000** for its
18 programs.

19 **Sec. 46.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
20 Vision Theatrical Foundation, Inc. the sum of \$10,000 for its programs.

21 **Sec. 47.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
22 Communities in Schools of Nevada the sum of \$1,000,000 for its programs.

23 **Sec. 48.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
24 Greater Youth Sports Association the sum of \$5,000 for its programs.

25 **Sec. 49.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
26 Obodo Collective the sum of \$10,000 for its programs.

27 **Sec. 50.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to U.S.
28 VETS - Las Vegas the sum of \$25,000 for its activities to assist in the successful
29 transition of military veterans and their families.

30 **Sec. 51.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
31 National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Southern Nevada the sum of \$25,000
32 for providing mental health support groups, classes, presentations and other
33 resources without charge.

34 **Sec. 52.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
35 Arriba Las Vegas Worker Center the sum of \$10,000 for its activities to develop,
36 educate and empower worker and migrant communities.

37 **Sec. 53.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Puentes
38 the sum of \$10,000 for its programs and services.

39 **Sec. 53.3.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
40 The Arc Nevada the sum of \$250,000 for its programs and services.

41 **Sec. 53.7.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to
42 the College of Southern Nevada the sum of \$4,500,000 for its Center For
43 Excellence in Public Safety.

44 **Sec. 54.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Teach
45 for America the sum of \$25,000 for its programs.

46 **Sec. 55.** Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by this act, the entity
47 that accepts the money agrees to:

48 1. Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or
49 before December 20, 2024, that describes each expenditure made from the money
50 appropriated by this act from the date on which the money was received by the
51 entity through December 1, 2024;

52 2. Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance Committee on or
53 before September 19, 2025, that describes each expenditure made from the money

1 appropriated by this act from the date on which the money was received by the
2 entity through June 30, 2025; and

3 3. Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the
4 Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other
5 records of information, confidential or otherwise, of the entity, regardless of their
6 form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit
7 of the use of the money appropriated by this act.

8 **Sec. 56.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by sections 1 to
9 54, inclusive, of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2025,
10 by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from
11 the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion
12 of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
13 September 19, 2025, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or
14 the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
15 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 19, 2025.

16 **Sec. 57.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
