AN ACT relating to off-highway vehicles; revising the definition of “large all-terrain vehicle”; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Existing law defines a “large all-terrain vehicle” as any all-terrain vehicle that  
2 includes seating capacity for at least two people abreast and: (1) total seating  
3 capacity for at least four people; or (2) a truck bed. (NRS 490.043) **Section 1.5** of  
4 this bill revises the definition of “large all-terrain vehicle” by removing the  
5 requirements that such a vehicle have total seating capacity for at least four people  
6 or a truck bed.
