Comment: We estimate that it would be \$50,000 to hire a consultant to complete the analysis, interviews with the underserved minority communities throughout the entire state of Nevada, prepare the report, and come up with proposed regulatory changes for the first year. Nevada has 14% low income residents according to the Census statics attached. We estimate that it would take the consultant approximately 2 months (app. 320 hours based upon 40 hrs/wk and 4 weeks per month) to do the work stated above at the rate of \$150 per hour (\$48,000) with travel expenses of \$2000. We estimate that there will be annual updates on the proposed regulatory changes with the consultant fees based upon 1 month (app. 160 hours at the rate of \$150 per hour) at the rate of \$24,000 with travel expenses of \$1000.
