To achieve the state's climate goals and reduce air pollutants, the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) fully supports the development of alternative fuels for vehicles; however, NDOT cannot determine the financial impact of this bill as it is written. NDOT supports the intention of SB451 and is actively collaborating with the departments listed in the bill to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and develop strategies for the use of alternative fuels statewide.

There is concern among NDOT that the distribution of responsibility and level of effort is unclear, as well as the roles and responsibilities of each agency. NDOT will continue developing plans for alternative fuels corridors, writing grants to access funding for alternative fuel growth, and assisting with the process of identifying and reducing regulatory barriers for the growth of zero-emission fuels.
