If the Supreme Court's budget closes as the Joint Money Committees voted on May 1, 2023, and SB488, which directs the State portion of administrative assessment revenue collected pursuant to NRS 176.059 to the General Fund passes and is approved by the Governor, then the AOC's fiscal note on this measure is substantively mitigated. The only outstanding fiscal item remaining becomes a potential reduction to the revenue available for specialty courts if the amount collected in administrative assessment revenue pursuant to NRS 176.0613 due to the reductions contemplated in amended version of AB369. However, we are unable to determine the actual potential impact of those reductions.
