BDR 52-753 is an act relating to public safety; setting forth certain requirements and restrictions concerning foil balloons; prohibiting, with certain exceptions, a person from selling/offering for sale/manufacturing a foil balloon that fails to meet certain requirements; providing penalties; and other matters.

Section 11 of this bill makes it unlawful for a person, with the intent to interfere or otherwise prevent the performance of the normal function of any infrastructure owned by a public utility, to: (1) commit any trespass upon the infrastructure; or (2) intentionally or recklessly deface, damage or tamper with the infrastructure.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 2 new NOCs and 2 new subtypes and modify 5 NOCs. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
