BDR 16-252 is an act relating to incarceration; setting forth certain rights of offenders and prisoners; requiring certain persons and governmental entities to take certain actions relating to such rights; providing for the designation of an ombudsman for each institution, facility or jail and prescribing the powers and duties relating to that position; revising provisions relating to training for correctional staff; revising provisions relating to a risk and needs assessment; prohibiting the use of restraints on a pregnant offender or prisoner who is being transferred or transported under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
