BDR 43-678 relates to off-highway vehicles and proposes to: revise the definition of large terrain vehicle and utility vehicle; allow the operation of these vehicles on certain roads and highways; authorize the OHV Commission to revise the designation of certain highways for OHV use; allow for registration of certain large OHV's upon request of the owner, and; clarifies provisions that operators of OHV's to hold a valid driver's license. This bill would become effective upon passage and approval for performing administrative preparation tasks, and January 1, 2024 for all other purposes.

The Department has reviewed this bill and determined there will be no impact as currently written. DMV already has established criteria and procedure in place for titling and registration of OHV's; the provisions of this bill would be incorporated into those existing operations, along with making conforming updates to policies and procedures, forms and websites.
