AB302 / BDR 43-984 is an act relating to public safety; providing for the issuance of a limited-purpose identification card to be used to provide identification for the purpose of challenging the accuracy or sufficiency of information relating to certain records of criminal history; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1-5 provides for the creation of limited use identification cards to be used for challenging a person's record of criminal history. Section 6 provides for criminal penalties.

If this bill as introduced is enacted, it would require the Department of Public Safety, Records Communications and Compliance Division (RCCD), Nevada Offense Code Unit (NOC) staff to create 4 new NOCs and 4 new subtypes. However, the cumulative impact of the legislation from the 2023 session will increase the volume of NOC revisions. The RCCD may request to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2023-2025 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
