If enacted, the proposed legislation would create the School Psychologist Interstate Licensure Compact and require that the Department develop, enact, and facilitate the Compact pursuant to sections 2, 3, and 5. The Department has identified the need for \$10,000/year in Compact membership dues; \$5,000 for revisions to the Licensure system; \$3,600/year in travel costs to attend Compact meetings; and approximately 40 hours of overtime for the Licensure Director to attend such meetings and 40 hours of overtime for an EPP position to support expanded school psychologists in schools.
