If enacted, the proposed legislation would create the Nevada Education Savings Account Program. Pursuant to Sec, 12, 14, 16, 17, 18, 21, 22, 23, 24, and 26, this would require the Department to develop regulations, review and approve applications and renewals, receive notification of select actions, issue guidance on per-pupil funding amounts, conduct audits, and review and develop annual reports. The Department has identified the need for 1 FTE EFS; 1 FTE Auditor II; 1 FTE MA2; and overtime for an EPP.
