Assembly Bill No. 353—AN ACT making an appropriation to the University of Nevada, Reno, for a technology initiative for certain students; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

By the Committee on Government Affairs:

Assembly Bill No. 354—AN ACT relating to governmental administration; revising the membership of the Nevada State Board on Geographic Names; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

Motion carried.

By the Committee on Ways and Means:

Assembly Bill No. 355—AN ACT relating to education; providing that any money remaining in the Fund to Assist School Districts in Financing Capital Improvements and the Fund to Assist Rural School Districts in Financing Capital Improvements at the end of the fiscal year does not revert to the State General Fund; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

By the Committee on Ways and Means:

Assembly Bill No. 356—AN ACT relating to public employees; revising certain deadlines relating to the negotiation, mediation and arbitration of collective bargaining agreements with the Executive Department of the State Government; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Government Affairs.

Motion carried.

By Assemblymembers Hunt, D'Silva and Jackson and Senator Cruz-Crawford:

Assembly Bill No. 357—AN ACT relating to employment; establishing requirements relating to the release of certain information in the Statewide Central Registry for the Collection of Information Concerning the Abuse or Neglect of a Child and the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal

History to public employers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Motion carried.

By Assemblymember Yeager:

Assembly Bill No. 358—AN ACT making appropriations to the United Way of Northern Nevada and the Sierra for the statewide implementation of Dolly Parton's Imagination Library program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Motion carried.

By Assemblymembers Gallant, Gurr, Gray, DeLong, Hibbetts and O'Neill:

Assembly Bill No. 359—AN ACT relating to taxes on retail sales; providing for the submission to the voters of the question whether the Sales and Use Tax Act of 1955 should be amended to provide an exemption from the tax for certain coins, currency and bullion; providing for the exemptions from certain analogous taxes if the voters approve this amendment to the Sales and Use Tax Act of 1955; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Revenue.

By Assemblymember Goulding:

Assembly Bill No. 360—AN ACT relating to health care; requiring the use of a rapid test when testing certain pregnant women for syphilis in certain circumstances; authorizing the discipline of certain health care facilities that violate that requirement; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Health and Human Services.

Motion carried.

By Assemblymember Hunt:

Assembly Bill No. 361—AN ACT relating to transportation; requiring a regional transportation commission in certain counties to take certain actions to mitigate safety risks to transit operators; authorizing a governmental entity that operates a public mass transportation system to obtain a public transportation trespass order under certain circumstances; providing a penalty for the violation of such an order; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Growth and Infrastructure.

Motion carried.

By Assemblymember Considine:

Assembly Bill No. 362—AN ACT relating to taxation; providing for the imposition, collection, administration and enforcement of taxes on the sale or transfer of a controlling interest in an entity which possesses an interest in real property in this State; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Revenue.

By the Committee on Natural Resources:

Assembly Bill No. 363—AN ACT relating to water; revising provisions relating to the establishment, membership and duties of a groundwater board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

By Assemblymember Anderson:

Assembly Bill No. 364—AN ACT relating to taxation; revising the pupils on whose behalf a scholarship organization is authorized to provide a grant under the Nevada Education Choice Scholarship Program; requiring a scholarship organization to notify the Department of Taxation if there are no pupils on whose behalf the scholarship organization is authorized to provide a grant; prohibiting the Department from approving applications for tax credits under the Program made by such a scholarship organization; requiring a scholarship organization to repay certain tax credits under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Jauregui moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Revenue.

Motion carried.

By the Committee on Education:

Assembly Bill No. 365—AN ACT relating to cannabis; repealing provisions requiring the University of Nevada, Reno, School of Medicine to establish a program for the evaluation and research of the medical use of cannabis in the care and treatment of persons who have been diagnosed with a chronic or debilitating medical condition; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Assemblymember Torres-Fossett moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Education.
