## Overview of the Commission on Statewide Rules of Criminal Procedure

- In early 2015, the Nevada Supreme Court convened the Commission on Statewide Rules of Criminal Procedure under the Co-Chairmanship of Justice Michael Cherry and Justice Michael Douglas. The Commission was created to address a lack of uniformity in criminal procedure rules across the state; the Commission membership is comprised of experienced legal professionals and members of the Nevada judiciary who are focused on examining key, criminal procedure concerns and making recommendations for improvement on a statewide level.
- Once recommendations for improvement have been provided, a statewide, public hearing will take place prior to adoption, implementation, or recommendations for legislative changes.
