

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF
THE STATE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE**

LCB File No. R073-97

Effective October 22, 1997

EXPLANATION--Matter in italics is new; matter in brackets [] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: NRS 561.105 and 590.070.

Section 1. NAC 590.065 is hereby amended to read as follows:

590.065 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the [~~division of agriculture of the department of business and industry~~] *state board of agriculture* hereby adopts by reference the specification guides for gasoline contained in volume 05.03, Petroleum Products and Lubricants, of the 1995 Annual Book of American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) Standards, ASTM designation D 4814-94d, except that footnote B in table 4 in volume 05.03 is excluded.

2. Volume 05.03 is available for inspection at the offices of the Division of Agriculture, Department of Business and Industry, 350 Capitol Hill Avenue, Reno, Nevada 89502 and 2300 McLeod Street, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104. [~~Sections of the~~] *The* volume may be purchased at a cost of [~~\$18 per section or the volume may be purchased in its entirety at a cost of~~] \$136 from the American Society for Testing and Materials, [~~1916 Race Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19103.~~] *100 Barr Harbor Drive, West Conshohocken, Pennsylvania 19428.*

3. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4, gasoline containing 9 percent ethanol by volume or more is permitted an additional pound per square inch on the vapor pressure specification.

4. Gasoline sold in Clark County between [November 16] *October 1* and the following [January 25] *March 30* must not exceed a vapor pressure of 9 pounds per square inch and must meet the specifications relating to distillation set forth for volatility class A, B or C in ASTM designation D 4814-94d.

5. A person shall not sell, offer for sale, supply or offer to supply in this state any gasoline, intended for use in a vehicle which is primarily driven on a highway:

(a) Represented as leaded gasoline on or before December 31, 1995, if it contains more than 0.10 gram of lead per gallon.

(b) On or after January 1, 1996, if:

(1) It contains more than 0.05 gram of lead per gallon;

(2) It contains more than 0.005 gram of phosphorus per gallon;

(3) Manganese or any compound of manganese has been added to the gasoline; or

(4) It contains more than 10 percent ethanol by volume.

6. A person shall not sell, offer for sale, supply or offer to supply in:

(a) The area of this state which is east of the 118th degree of west longitude and north of the 38th degree of north latitude, any gasoline which contains more than 800 parts per million of sulfur.

(b) Any other area of this state which is not described in paragraph (a), any gasoline which contains more than 300 parts per million of sulfur.
