

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE
COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE**

Effective November 14, 1997

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: Sections 53 and 223 of chapter 586, Statutes of Nevada 1997.

Section 1. Chapter 689A of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

The commissioner will interpret the term “short-term health insurance policy” as it is used in section 15 of chapter 586, Statutes of Nevada 1997, to exclude an individual health insurance policy that is:

1. Issued to provide coverage for not more than 185 days or is extended to provide coverage until the end of a period of hospitalization for a condition for which the person covered by the policy is hospitalized on the day the coverage would have otherwise ended; and

2. Nonrenewable or is extended to provide coverage for the period of hospitalization described in subsection 1,

if the total period of coverage is not more than 185 consecutive days within a 365-day period plus any additional days for which coverage is provided because of that hospitalization.
