

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE
BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS**

LCB File No. R123-97

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §§1-4, NRS 488.045, 501.181 and 501.243.

Section 1. NAC 488.455 is hereby amended to read as follows:

488.455 1. On the following waters, a vessel must be operated at a speed that leaves a flat wake, but in no case may a vessel be operated at a speed in excess of 5 nautical miles per hour:

(g) The lagoon south of Laughlin within sec. 33, T. 32 S., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M., as marked with signs or buoys, or both.....	Clark
(h) Likes Lake.....	Churchill
(i) The Pitt Taylor Arm of Rye Patch Reservoir.....	Pershing

- (j) Illipah Reservoir White Pine
- (k) Mason Valley Wildlife Management Area Lyon
- (l) Upper Wall Canyon Reservoir Washoe
- (m) Echo Canyon Reservoir Lincoln
- (n) Silver Creek Reservoir White Pine
- (o) Key Pittman Wildlife Management Area Lincoln

2. All boat harbors and other areas designated by buoys on any of the following waters are zones in which a vessel must be operated at a speed that leaves a flat wake, but in no case may a vessel be operated at a speed in excess of 5 nautical miles per hour:

(i) Topaz Lake, Boat Ramps	Douglas
(j) Colorado River, adjacent to Harrah’s Casino in Laughlin.....	Clark

Sec. 2. NAC 488.458 is hereby amended to read as follows:

488.458 1. The commission hereby designates areas for mooring or anchoring vessels within the following locations:

(a) On Lake Mohave, the location established as Cottonwood Cove by the superintendent of the Lake Mead National Recreation Area.

(b) On Lake Mead, the locations established as:

- (1) Boulder Harbor;
- (2) Calville Bay;
- (3) Echo Bay;
- (4) Las Vegas Bay; and
- (5) Overton Beach,

by the superintendent of the Lake Mead National Recreation Area.

(c) On Lake Tahoe, Glenbrook Bay and Zephyr Cove Marina located in Douglas County.

2. The areas designated by the commission *pursuant to subsection 1* will be marked in accordance with the provisions of NRS 488.265.

3. *Vessels are prohibited from mooring or anchoring on the Colorado River within the area designated by buoys at Harrah's Casino in Laughlin.*

Sec. 3. NAC 488.465 is hereby amended to read as follows:

488.465 Vessels are prohibited in areas which are designated by *signs or* buoys as follows:

1. Within the Lake Mead National Recreation Area;
2. On the Colorado River [below] :
 - (a) *Below* Davis Dam; *and*
 - (b) *At the swimming area of Harrah's Casino in Laughlin;*
3. On Lake Tahoe at:
 - (a) The main beaches at Sand Harbor and Divers' Cove within Lake Tahoe State Park;
 - (b) The swimming area of the Incline Village General Improvement District and Burnt Cedar Beach;
 - (c) The swimming area of Galilee at the Episcopal Camp and Conference Center;
 - (d) The swimming area of the Lakeridge General Improvement District;
 - (e) The swimming area of the Glenbrook Homeowner's Association;
 - (f) The swimming area of the Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe;
 - (g) The swimming area of the Zephyr Cove Marina; and
 - (h) The swimming area of Crystal Shores West;
4. At the dam and swim beach at the state recreation area in Rye Patch Reservoir;
5. At Lahontan Reservoir Dam;
6. At South Fork Reservoir Dam;

- 7. At Wildhorse Reservoir Dam;
- 8. At Eagle Valley Dam at Spring Valley State Park;
- 9. At Chimney Reservoir Dam in Humboldt County; and
- 10. At the county swim beach at Topaz Lake.

Sec. 4. NRS 488.470 is hereby amended to read as follows:

488.470 *1.* Only boats without motors are permitted on the following waters:

[1.] <i>(a)</i> Angel Lake.....	Elko
[2.] <i>(b)</i> Blue Lakes	Humboldt
[3.] <i>Groves Lake</i>	<i>Lander</i>

[5.] <i>Tonkin Reservoir</i>	<i>Eureka</i>
[6.] <i>(d)</i> Spooner Lake	Douglas
[7.] <i>(e)</i> Marlette Lake	Washoe

2. Only boats without motors and boats with electric motors are permitted on Groves Lake located in Lander County.
