

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE COMMISSION ON MENTAL
HEALTH AND MENTAL RETARDATION**

LCB File No. R128-97

Effective November 14, 1997

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §§1-3, NRS 433.324.

Section 1. NAC 433.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

433.040 Each division facility shall use the following definitions [for the purpose of counting] *to count* the number of persons in this state who are [chronically mentally ill adults or severely emotionally disturbed youths:

1. “Chronically mentally ill adult”] *adults with a serious mental illness or children with a serious emotional disturbance:*

1. “Adult with a serious mental illness” means a person who [:

(a) Is] *is* at least 18 years old [;

(b) Has] *and has* been diagnosed *within the immediately preceding 12 months* as having [:

(1) A DSM III-R Axis I:

(I) Schizophrenia;

(II) Delusional disorder;

(III) Psychotic disorder not elsewhere classified; or

(IV) Mood disorder; or

(2) A DSM III-R Axis II personality disorder resulting in severe and persistent dysfunctional behavior;

(c) Has undergone treatment for mental illness more intensive than outpatient care more than once; and

(d) Has been assigned a DSM III-R Axis V Global Assessment of Functioning Scale rating of 50 or less within the preceding 12 months.

2. “Severely emotionally disturbed youth”] *a mental, behavioral or emotional disorder as defined in the “Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders,” as adopted by reference in NAC 433.050, other than an addictive disorder, mental retardation, irreversible dementia or a disorder caused by an abuse of alcohol or drugs, which interferes with or limits one or more major life activities of the adult.*

2. “Child with a serious emotional disturbance” means a person who [:

(a) Is] *is* less than 18 years old [;

(b) Has] *and has* been diagnosed *within the immediately preceding 12 months* as having a [DSM III-R Axis I or Axis II emotional disorder;

(c) Has exhibited signs of being emotionally disturbed for more than 1 year;

(d) Has required or will require interventions from at least one public service agency other than a mental health agency; and

(e) Has been assigned a DSM III-R Axis V Global Assessment of Functioning Scale rating of 50 or less within the preceding 12 months.

For the purposes of this section, “DSM III-R” means the “Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders,” 3rd Ed. Revised 1987, published by the American Psychiatric Association.]

mental, behavioral or emotional disorder as defined in the “Diagnostic and Statistical Manual

of Mental Disorders,” as adopted by reference in NAC 433.050, other than a mental disorder designated as a Code V disorder in the manual, a developmental disorder or a disorder caused by an abuse of alcohol or drugs, which substantially interferes with or the limits the child from developing social, behavioral, cognitive, communicative or adaptive skills or his activities relating to family, school or community. The term does not include a child with a disorder which is temporary or is an expected response to stressful events.

Sec. 2. NAC 433.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:

433.050 The “Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders,” [3rd Ed. Revised 1987,] *4th Edition Revised 1994*, published by the American Psychiatric Association, Washington, D.C. [,] *and commonly referred to as “DSM,”* is hereby adopted by reference. This manual may be obtained from *the* American Psychiatric Press, Inc., 1400 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20005, for the price of [~~\$29.95.~~] *\$45, plus \$7.50 for shipping and handling.*

Sec. 3. NAC 433.020 and 433.030 are hereby repealed.
