

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF  
THE STATE QUARANTINE OFFICER**

**LCB File No. R225-97**

Effective June 23, 1998.

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [ ] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §§ 1 and 2, NRS 554.020.

**Section 1.** NAC 554.120 is hereby amended to read as follows:

554.120 The following areas are infested with:

1. Both Dutch elm disease and phloem necrosis virus: Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Massachusetts, *Mississippi*, Missouri, Nebraska, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Virginia and West Virginia.

2. Only Dutch elm disease:

(a) In California, the counties of [:

(1) *Contra Costa*;

(2) *Marin*;

(3) *Napa*;

(4) *San Francisco*;

(5) *San Mateo*;

(6) *Santa Clara*;

(7) *Solano*; and

(8) *Sonoma*; and] *Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solana and Sonoma.*

(b) Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, Idaho, Maine, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, *Montana*, New Hampshire, North Dakota, Oregon, Rhode Island, *South Carolina*, South Dakota, Texas, Vermont, Washington, Wisconsin, Wyoming and the District of Columbia.

**Sec. 2.** NAC 554.140 is hereby amended to read as follows:

554.140 Entry into Nevada is prohibited for the following commodities, whether or not they are moved directly from an infested or infected area or are diverted or reconsigned from another area:

1. Any commodity described in NAC 554.130 which originated or was grown in or was shipped from an area listed in subsection 1 or 2 of NAC 554.120 as being infected with Dutch elm disease; and

2. Any commodity described in subsection 2 of NAC 554.130 which originated or was grown in or was shipped from an area listed in subsection 1 [or 3] of NAC 554.120 as being infected with phloem necrosis virus.
