

PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE NEVADA STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

A workshop to discuss the proposed regulation was conducted on December 4, 1997, and presented to the board at the January 21, 22, 1998, board meeting. This proposed regulation will be presented to the board for final approval at the March 11 and 12, 1998, board meeting.

R022-98 NAC 453.475 - New managing pharmacist inventory, biennial inventory any date

453.475 Inventory of controlled substances by new managing pharmacist.

1. A pharmacist who is hired or promoted to manage a pharmacy pursuant to the provisions of NRS 639.220 shall, within 48 hours after he first reports for duty as the managing pharmacist, conduct an inventory of the controlled substances of the pharmacy with the pharmacist who preceded him as the managing pharmacist. The pharmacists shall sign the inventory.

2. The inventory required by subsection 1 must be:

- (a) Conducted according to the method prescribed by the provisions of 21 C.F.R. Part 1304;
- (b) Placed in the records of the controlled substances of the pharmacy; and
- (c) Copied and the copy must be mailed to the board within 10 days after the date the pharmacist first reports to duty as the managing pharmacist.

3. The inventory may serve as a biennial controlled substance inventory beginning date and the inventory must be taken within two years of the previous inventory.

4. A biennial controlled substance inventory pursuant to NRS 453.246 may be conducted on any date desired as long as the inventory is taken within two years of the previous biennial inventory.
