**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE NEVADA STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY**

A workshop to discuss the proposed regulation was conducted on December 4, 1997, and presented to the board at the January 21, 22, 1998, board meeting. This proposed regulation will be presented to the board for final approval at the March 11 and 12, 1998, board meeting.

R023-98 NAC 453.480 - Red C

**453.480 Maintenance of prescription files for controlled substances.** In maintaining files of prescriptions a [pharmacist] pharmacy or dispensing practitioner must elect one of the following options:

1. To maintain two files:
  - (a) One file for substances in schedule II; and
  - (b) The other file for substances in schedules III, IV and V and for noncontrolled substances if the prescriptions for controlled substances are stamped in the lower right hand corner with the letter "C" in red ink at least 1 inch in height. If the pharmacy or dispensing practitioner uses a computerized system for recording information concerning prescriptions, the prescriptions do not need the marking of the red "C" on prescriptions for schedules III, IV and V.
2. To maintain two files:
  - (a) One file for substances in schedules II, III, IV and V, if the prescriptions for substances in schedules III, IV and V are stamped, or not stamped, with the red letter "C" as set forth in paragraph (b) of subsection 1; and
  - (b) The other file for prescriptions for noncontrolled substances.
3. To maintain three files:
  - (a) One file for substances in schedule II;
  - (b) A second file for substances in schedules III, IV and V; and
  - (c) A third file for substances other than controlled substances.
