**NOTICE OF WORKSHOP TO SOLICIT COMMENTS
ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS**

The Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety, Committee on Testing for Intoxication, is proposing to amend regulations pertaining to Chapter 484 of the Nevada Administrative Code. A workshop has been set for 9:00 A.M., October 23, 1998 at the Washoe County Sheriffs Office, 911 Parr Blvd., Reno, NV 89512. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics addressed in the proposed regulation amendments.

Topic to be discussed:

1. Addition of National Interlock model WR2, manufactured by National Interlock Systems, Inc. to NAC 484.607.

A copy of this notice and the proposed amendment will be on file at the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. **PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PUBLIC SAFETY**

Section 1. NAC 484.607 is hereby amended to read as follows:

484.607 The following devices are approved and certified as being designed and manufactured to be accurate and reliable to determine the percent by weight of alcohol in a person's breath when the test is taken to prevent an intoxicated person from starting a vehicle:

1. Intoxalock, Consumer Safety Technology, Inc.
2. Draeger Interlock, manufactured by Draeger.
3. *National Interlock model WR2, National Interlock Systems, Inc.*
