

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS**

AUTHORITY: NRS 501.105 and 501.181.

Section 1. Chapter 503 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a person shall not hunt or take any wildlife, or assist a person in the hunting or taking of wildlife, in a management unit for at least 96 hours after he has:

(a) Flown in any aircraft over the management unit; or

(b) Been provided information concerning the observation or location of wildlife that was obtained with the use of an aircraft that has flown over the management unit.

2. The provisions of this section do not:

(a) Apply to an aircraft that is operated on a regularly scheduled basis by a commercial airline.

(b) Authorize any act that is prohibited by NRS 503.010.

3. As used in this section:

(a) "Aircraft" means any device or contrivance that is propelled by an engine and used for navigation of, or flight in, the air.

(b) *“Management unit” means a management unit described in NAC 504.210.*
