**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE  
STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION**

**PROPOSED REVISIONS TO NEVADA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE  
CHAPTER 389 COURSES OF STUDY**

**Explanation:** Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets **[ ]** is material to be omitted.

**AUTHORITY:** NRS 385.080, 389.015

**SECTION 1** Chapter 389 is hereby amended by adding new language as follows:

**SECTION 2:** Certificate of Attendance

**SECTION 3:** *“Certificate of attendance” defined. “Certificate of attendance” means a certificate which evidences that a pupil has satisfied all of the requirements for high school graduation or program of adult education, including completion of required Carnegie units, but fails to pass one or more portions of the Nevada High School Proficiency Examination.*

**SECTION 4:** *Requirements for certificate of attendance.*

- 1. A certificate of attendance is issued to a person who has satisfied all of the requirements for high school graduation or program of adult education, including completion of required Carnegie Units, but fails to pass one or more portions of the Nevada High School Proficiency Examination.*
- 2. A pupil who qualifies for a certificate of attendance and who subsequently passes all portions of the Nevada High School Proficiency Examination may receive the appropriate high school diploma or, in the case of an adult education pupil, an adult standard diploma in accordance with the procedure in place in the pupil’s school district.*
- 3. A pupil who qualifies for a certificate of attendance shall not be counted as a dropout.*
- 4. A certificate of attendance is not a high school or adult diploma.*

**SECTION 5:** *Effective date: January 1, 2000.*
